Notes For Anything I Missed:

TRADITIONAL WEDDING TIME-TABLE

Hour 1 - Social Gathering for wedding guests - Cocktail Hour. Photos for bridal party.
Hour 2 - Dinner. Are there toasts? Speeches? Cake Cutting?
Hour 3 - Party starts. Bride & groom 1st dance. Father daughter dance. Mother son dance.
Hour 4 - Bridal Party Grand March - The wedding party is announced. Traditionally they are announced in the following order: groom's parents, bride's parents, flower girl and ring bearer, bridesmaids escorted by groomsmen, maid/ matron of honor escorted by the best man and finally the Bride and Groom.
Hour 5 - Bouquet toss, garter belt toss, last song of the night
